From The Mayor

The new Village budget has passed and will go into effect on June 1st, 2023. Some of the Public Works projects we have planned are milling and re-paving East Main Street, removal and replacement of the decorative stamped concrete in the business district, new equipment purchases, drainage, sidewalk and piping work in addition to the water main replacement project on South Ave./State St. and the sewer I and I study. A busy spring, summer and fall season to say the least. Here's hoping for good weather!

Water & Sewer Relevy

At the end of April any overdue uncollected water and sewer rents will be re-levied onto the Village tax bills that arrive in June. Any overdue payments paying by check must be **received** by April 15th or you may pay overdue amounts by cash or credit card up till April 30th. You may use a credit card to pay your water bill on our website at bloomfieldny.org.

Village Tax Bills

The Village Tax Bills will be going out in June. Tax bills are due by July 1st to avoid penalties. Tax bills can be paid in person at our office Monday through Thursday from 8am-4pm or online at www.bloomfieldny.org. For your convenience, there is also a mail slot to drop payments off in the door when the office is closed. Any checks incorrectly made out, have the wrong amount written, or postdated will be returned and subject to a penalty if received by the Tax Receiver after the penalty free period.

Spring Brush Removal

The brush removal program is scheduled for the week of May 15th. Please keep the brush away from trees and poles. Place the brush parallel to the curb so the backhoe is able `to grab the brush easily. For further information contact the DPW at 657-7319. If you would like to drop off your brush, the DPW is open during regular working hours of 7am-4pm Mondays through Thursdays, and from 7:30am until 10am on Fridays. It will also be open on the last Saturday of the month in June, July, August and September from 9am-2pm.



New Village Offices

Our office was contacted by the Episcopal Diocese of Rochester to see if we would be interested in purchasing the St. Peter's Church property located at 44 Main St. The Church dissolved on 10/31/2021. Whenever the Diocese has a property for sale, they try to sell to the local municipality if possible. As many of you are aware, we are currently renting our office space at 12 Main St. If we purchase the property, we will no longer have to pay rent. After much Board discussion, it was decided that it would benefit the Village to own property and not pay rent anymore. We have the funds to purchase the property at a cost of only \$40,000. This would pay for itself in 3.5 years. We have been looking for our own location for many years and have saved for when this day came. With that being said, we will hopefully be closing in the next couple of weeks. We have work to do both outside and inside before we move in but hopefully, we will be moving in early fall.

Also, congratulations to Gail Harrington and David Poole for being reelected to the Village Board of Trustees.

Village Budget

The new budget tax rate is going down from \$2.46 per \$1000 to \$2.23 per \$1000; the amount of the levy went down from \$203,916 to \$185,000. The water and sewer rates have remained the same as last year.

Rabies Clinics

Because we have documented rabies in our county. New York State Law requires every dog, cat, and ferret at least 3 months of age be vaccinated against rabies at all times. Each year Ontario County Public Health provides six free rabies clinics throughout the county. The 2023 rabies clinics run from 9AM-Noon and are scheduled for the following dates and: April 29th, June 17th, August 5th, September 16th, and October 28th. All clinics will be held at the Ontario County Public Works at 2962 County Road 48 in Canandaigua. Clinics are FREE but donations are appreciated. Dogs, Cats and ferrets must be healthy and at least 12 weeks old. Bring your most recent rabies certificate with you if possible. Pets must be on a leash or in a carrier.
